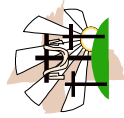

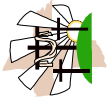

**Notes:**

1. Please notify the `Diocese in Europe` if you change your name or address while the pledge is still in force. You can cancel the pledge at any time by notifying the `Diocese in Europe` it will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of cancellation or such later date as you specify.
2. You must pay an amount of UK income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that `Diocese in Europe` reclaims on your donation in the tax year (From April 2008 25p for each £1 you give).
3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay UK tax on your income/capital gains equal to the tax that the `Diocese in Europe` claims, you can cancel your pledge (see note 1).
4. If you pay at a higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
5. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask the `Diocese in Europe`. Or you can ask your local tax office for leaflet IR 113 Gift Aid.
